

HOW TO GET TO VENICE

GETTING TO VENICE BY PLANE ARRIVAL AT MARCO POLO AIRPORT IN VENICE (VCE)

From Marco Polo airport you can reach Mestre or Venice by land (bus or taxi) or take the water route (Alilaguna boat or water taxi).

PUBLIC WATER TRANSPORTATION BY ALILAGUNA

A water bus transport service is available from the airport docks to Venice and the main Venetian islands (Murano, Burano, Lido).

The water bus transport service is provided by [Alilaguna](#).

Alilaguna waterbus ticket is €15 one-way and €27 round-trip.

Please check the Alilaguna website for timetables, routes and tickets.

Tickets are available online, by the ticket machines located by the arrival hall and by the docks, or on board of the Alilaguna waterbus.

ACTV AND ATVO BUSES

Piazzale Roma is the only place in Venice that can be reached by car or bus. To reach Piazzale Roma from Marco Polo Airport, we suggest you to take [ACTV](#) n. 5 bus or [ATVO Aerobus](#) Venezia Express bus. The ticket is 10 € one-way or € 15 round-trip. The bus takes approximately 30 minutes from the airport to the bus stop in Piazzale Roma.

Tickets are available online, by the ticket machines located by the arrival hall and at the bus stops or, only for ATVO, online.

CAR TAXI SERVICE

Car taxi takes about 20 minutes to reach Piazzale Roma from Marco Polo airport. We suggest, before getting on board, to ask the taxi staff for more details on the fare that will be applied, please find below the main car taxi companies:

WATER TAXI SERVICE

You can arrange a private water taxi for transfers to/from Marco Polo Airport. It takes about 30 minutes to reach Venice from the airport. The cost is about €120/130 per boat. For more details on the rates that will be applied, ask the staff in charge before booking or boarding the boat.

WATER PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

The public transport company in Venice's historic center is [ACTV](#) and has several waterbus lines that connect the city using mainly the waterways of the Grand Canal and Giudecca Canal.

The cost of a ride is €9.50. You can purchase tourist tickets (for 1, 2, 3 or 7 days) on the Actv Venezia Unica company website.

PRIVATE WATER TAXI SERVICE

You can arrange a private boat for fast transfers in Venice. Water taxi costs depend on your final destination. For more details on the rate that will be applied, ask the staff in charge before booking or boarding the boat.

HOW TO REACH CA' FOSCARI UNIVERSITY MAIN BUILDING
